Camp ClapHans is a residential summer camp for children with disabilities. The camp is for kids ages 8 to 18 and offers them a place where they can explore, create, learn, try, play and make new friends.

The camp is located on the J.D. McCarty Center's property at 2002 E. Robinson St. in Norman. It features two cabins and an activities building. The camp is also located next to an 11-acre lake.

At camp, kids have the opportunity to try exciting activities, including archery, arts and crafts, canoeing, fishing, dances, horseback riding, stargazing and swimming. Campers also get to visit a local water park.
