The C.A.R.E. program is a collaboration among professionals from the J.D. McCarty Center for children with developmental disabilities, the Department of Human Services and Developmental Disability Services who work together to serve caregivers of children with a perceived or confirmed diagnosis of an intellectual or developmental disability.

WHO WE HELP

The program assists children from birth to 21 years old.

This community outreach program works to meet the needs of the caregivers and children through empowerment and self-determination using a person-centered, strengths-based, solution-focused approach.

Our clients include former patients of the J.D. McCarty Center, children in OKDHS and DDS Foster Care, individuals on the DDS waitlist, referrals from OKDHS hotline, referrals from other service providers or other families served by the program.
