ABOUT US

The C.A.R.E. Program is a community outreach program offered by the J.D. McCarty Center that works closely with DHS and DDS (Developmental Disabilities Services) to provide services to caregivers of individuals with perceived or confirmed diagnoses of intellectual and/or developmental disabilities.

We connect the caregivers to local and state resources, make referrals to different services (therapies, medication management, etc.), assist with school supports, consult with the JDMC therapy team, provide behavioral supports and more. This service is offered to the caregiver at no cost.

WHO WE HELP -

The program assists children from birth to 21 years old from across the state. Our clients include former patients of the J.D. McCarty Center, children in OKDHS and DDS Foster Care, individuals on the DDS waitlist, schools, other service providers or families.

WHAT WE OFFER -

Our behavioral supports include behavior assessments, behavior plans, trainings and diagnosis education.

Additional services include:

- * Evaluating needs through an initial assessment
- * Building bridges with families and support services
- * Connecting families with behavioral support services and medication assessments
- * Linking families to community resources, services and training based on the specialized support needs of their loved one
- * In-house referrals for therapy services
